	Bulbophyllum Elizabeth Ann 'Buckleberry' FCC/AOS	BS	30	<i>Huge red flowers on this reliable old favourite. Easy to grow and flower.</i>

	Paphiopedilum bellatulum	BS	40	<i>Big round white flowers heavily spotted with wine. Stunning.</i>
	Paphiopedilum charlesworthii	BS	55	<i>Small growing species with huge pink dorsal</i>
	Paphiopedilum delenatii	BS	40	<i>White, pink flushed slipper with darker pink pouch. Only Paph that is fragrant</i>
	Paphiopedilum glaucophyllum	BS	45	<i>White, green, and maroon slippers with short twisted petals that are produced sequentially over many, many months.</i>
	Paphiopedilum henryanum	BS	45	<i>Used in hybrids for mini paphs. Lots of spots and a pink pouch.</i>
	Paphiopedilum venustum	BS	70	<i>One only of this hard-to-find species. Lovely veined pouch.</i>
	Paphiopedilum rothschildianum	BS	80	<i>The king of all Paphs. Magnificent flowers. Multifloral</i>
	Paphiopedilum Gloria Naugle	BS	75	<i>(rothschildianum x micranthum) Stunning multifloral. Lots of dark maroon stripes on a light green base.</i>
	Paphiopedilum Yung Jai Century	BS	25	<i>This cross has beautiful mottled leaves. Easy to grow. This cross will produce mostly pure green and white flowers. (Hsinying Beam x Hsinying Mishima)</i>
	Paphiopedilum Hung Sheng Bay x Hung Sheng Sea	BS	25	<i>Lovely mottled leaves producing a beautiful slipper in various combinations of red, green, and white. Some will be solid red vinis. Every one will be different with unique variegated foliage. Great starter slippers.</i>
	Paphiopedilum Paradise in Burgundy	BS	45	<i>(After James x King Charles) Red with the large full pink dorsal of the charlesworthii grandparent.</i>
	Paphiopedilum Grand Paradise	BS	45	<i>(bellatulum x Jennifer Reinoso) Large white flowers heavily spotted burgundy. Vigorous.</i>
