Bulbophyllum Elizabeth Ann 'Buckleberry' FCC/AOS	BS	30	Huge red flowers on this reliable old favourite. Easy to grow and flower.
Bulbophyllum frostii	BS	30	Small plants with cute wooden shoe shaped cream flower heavily spotted with red - burgundy.
Bulbophyllum gracillimum	BS	35	Miniature plants that form medium clumps. Pink to purple fragrant flowers with long wiry sepals apear in umbells
Bulbophyllum grandiflorum	BS	35	Large tan and white flowers on compact plants. These flowers are very singular in shape. Very unusual and intriguing
Bulbophyllum longiflorum 'Crownfox' CCM/AOS	BS	25	Whorls of cream flowers speckled and suffused dark burgundy on vigorous plants. Spectacular!
Bulbophyllum medusae	BS	35	Long pure white flower presented in big shaggy umbel's Looks more like Cousin IT than the goddess Medusa to me.

Paphiopedilum Hung Sheng Bay x Hung Sheng Sea	BS	25	Lovely mottled leaves producing a beautiful slipper in various combinations of red, green, and white. Some will be solid red vinis. Every one will be different with unique variegated foliage. Great starter slippers.
Paphiopedilum Paradise in Burgundy	BS	45	(After James x King Charles) Red with the large full pink dorsal of the charlesworthii grandparent.

Phragmipedium Fireworks	BS	55	(Grande x pearcei) The pearcei parent has brought down the size of the plant. Even with shorter petals than Grande the flowers are still majestic.
Phragmipedium Fritz Schomburg	BS	75	One of the best of the kovachii hybrids. Good grower and huge magenta to orange flowers (kovachii x besseae)
Phragmipedium Hanne Popow	BS	50	Reliable, easy grower with sequentially opening flowers in pink to orange to bicolour tones. (schlimii x besseae)
Phragmipedium Mini Grande	BS	65	Smaller growing Phrag. with stately long twisted petals. (humboldtii x pearcei) Multi growth plants.

Phragmipedium Predator 4N	BS	80	This long petaled hybrid has the advantage of two highly coloured parents. (richteri x humboldtii) These flowers are gorgeous! Multi-growth plants
Phragmipedium QF Maria	BS	60	(lindleyanum x dalessandroi) Good grower producing impressive branched inflorescences with brilliant orange red flower.
Phragmipedium Zapatilla de la Virgen	BS	100	Deeply coloured with extremely long petals. Stunning. (humboldii 'Fortuna x warszewiczianum)

Phalaenopsis mannii v black	BS	40	Stunning stellate light yellow flowers with black markings. Miniature plant size
Phalaenopsis schilleriana	BS	45	Stunning mottled leaves with lots of big pik flowers. Often fragrant (Wild Mindoro x Ten Shin No. 1 (4n))
Phalaenopsis bellina	BS	40	('red Apple' x f, alba) Warm growing very fragrant yellow and pink stellate flowers.
Phalaenopsis stuartiana	BS	45	('Sogo'x v. nobilis) This is cross of the white and yellow forms so will be white to yellow with colourful spotting . Pretty silvered leaves.

Pleurothallis palliolata 'Eichenfels'	BS	25	Pink clam shells on heart shaped leaves. We grow this because we love the shape of the leaves
Pleurothallis scuerula	BS	30	Elongated heart-shaped leaves with pulpit shaped cream flowers
Pleurothallis sp'Burning sands'	BS	25	Mahogany flowers .Vigorous grower.
Restrepia cuprea 'Copper Jewel' CHM/AOS	BS	30	Brilliant orange flowers appear almost all year round. Miniature.
Restrepia brachypus 'Bird's Eye'	BS	30	Vvigorous miniature grower with reddish flowers on and off throughout the year.
Scaphosepalum digitale	BS	30	Mature plants are very small, forming little tuffs. Dark pink flowers. Intermediate temperatures.

Angraecum sesquipedale	NBS	40	Known as Darwin's orchid for its long nectary. Or the Christmas Star for its huge white flowers during the Christmas season.
Angraecum Longiscott	BS	45	(longicalcar x scottianum) Numerous non resupinate pure white flowers with long green nectaries. Stunning.
Anguloa ruckeri	BS	60	Magnificent deep red tulip shaped flowers. Very impressive
Brasilorchis schunkiana	BS	30	Miniature with deep ebony flowers. Now in bloom
Cyclopogon lindleyanus 'Silver Screen' CBR/AOS	BS	30	Miniature grown for its striking, striped leaves.
Leptotes bicolor	BS	25	Miniature mounted plants with white and fuchsia flowers.
