Epidendrum porpax	BS	25	<i>Miniature that quickly grows into a mat. Unusual red flowers that are large for the size of the growths. Does well mounted.</i>
Epidendrum rigidum	BS	25	<i>Large miniature with interesting green flowers. Easy to grow.</i>
Epidendrum schechterianum	BS	25	<i>Miniature that quickly grows into mats and covers itself with green flowers. Does very well mounted</i>
Rhyncholaelia digbyana	BS	40	<i>Highly fragrant ice-green flowers with deeply fringed lip. High light</i>
Brassocattleya Morning Glory	BS	40	<i>(B. nodosa x C. purpurata) Large white stars veined and blushed with magenta. Very fragrant. Stunning.</i>
Brassocattleya Nakornpathome Silver	BS	30	<i>(Bc. Binosa x B. nodosa) Green stars with large white magenta spotted lips. Fragrant</i>
Cattleya Cariad's Mini-Quinee 'Angel Kiss'	BS	35	<i>(Mini Purple x intermedia) Blue minicat with blue flushed petals and dark blue lip. Fragrant. Show stopper</i>

Coelogyne huetneriana var lactea	BS	25	<i>Similar to flaccida. Slightly larger plants with the flowers emerging higher above the foliage. Fragrant. Often called 'the milk white coelogyne'</i>
Coelogyne marmorata 'Black Lace' AM/AOS	BS	45	<i>Stunning Cream flowers with black lace on the lip</i>
Coelogyne pachystachya	BS	45	<i>Pink bracts set off the cream flowers with bright caramel lip.</i>
Coelogyne speciosa 'Mint Daiquiri'	BS	30	<i>Medium sized plants that produce fairly long-lasting sequentially opening flowers. Mildly musk scented. This one has green sepals and petals with the usual white tipped dark brown lip.</i>
Coelogyne speciosa 'Salmon'	BS	30	<i>We like this species so well we grow it in several colour forms. This one is light salmon.</i>
Coelogyne speciosa 'Sunrise Explosion'	BS	30	<i>And this one is the yellow form.....</i>
Coelogyne trinervis	BS	25	<i>Medium size plant. White with red-brown lip. Fragrant.</i>
Coelogyne xyrekes	BS	40	<i>Unusual Salmon flowers with almost black lips. Stunning.</i>

Dendrobium aberrans	BS	30	<i>Diminutive plants white crystalline white flowers veined with light green.</i>
Dendrobium Frosty Dawn	BS	35	<i>(Dawn Maree x Lime Frost) Striking very light-yellow flowers. Intense orange lips are darker centrally. Very long lasting.</i>
Dendrobium Nestor 'Red Dragon'	BS	35	<i>(parishii x anosum) Bright pink flowers appear on old growths. This nobile type cross does not need the very cold treatment that some do. Easy to flower.</i>
Dendrobium jenkinsii	BS	30	<i>Miniature mounted plants that produce bright yellow flowers with fringed lips after a cool dry winter rest.</i>
Dendrobium jydii	BS	25	<i>New dendrobium species. White flowers on medium plants. Very pretty.</i>
Dendrobium leonis	BS	30	<i>Overlapping succulent leaves make stiff braids that form interesting compact plants. Flowers light yellow stippled maroon on the outside.</i>
Dendrobium lindleyi	BS	30	<i>A larger version of the above species which produces longer inflorescences of bright yellow flowers after a cool, dry winter rest.</i>
Dendrobium linguiforme	BS	30	<i>Succulent leafed alternating growths. White fragrant flowers. Miniature usually grown mounted.</i>
Dendrobium parishiii	BS	30	<i>Multi caned plants that produce pretty bright pink flowers with a contrasting dark eye.</i>
Dendrobium parishiii f. album	BS	35	<i>The pure white form of this pretty species. Blooms on old growths for many years.</i>
Dendrobium purpureum	BS	20	<i>Green tipped bright magenta petals on flowers produced just about any time. Will reflower on leafless pendulous canes.</i>

Dendrobium Rainbow Dance	BS	25	<i>(Kurenai x unicum) Small plants producing lots of pink flowers more than once a year. Very rewarding and easy to grow.</i>
Dendrobium Colonial Maid	BS	20	<i>Small plants with lots of bright magenta flowers. (bigibum x falcorostrum)</i>
Dendrobium Hibiki	BS	30	<i>(Den. bracteosum x Den. laevifolium) Hot pink flowers are produced on old canes over and over again. Remains in flower for months. Compact plants</i>
Dendrobium Ueang Phueng	BS	25	<i>Mini plants with lots of sunshine yellow flowers in early spring. (jenkensis x lindleyi) Lightly scented.</i>
Dendrobium spectabile	nBS	45	<i>Bizarre twisted golden flowers marked with burgundy on this difficult to find species. Gorgeous!</i>

Dendrochilum bicallosum 'Pink Agate'	BS	25	<i>Beautiful spirals of pink-coral cascades on small well-behaved plants.</i>
Dendrochilum cobbianum 'Porcelain'	BS	25	<i>Long light gold arching chains with slight musky sent. Very nice display.</i>
Dendrochilum filiforme 'King Midas'	BS	25	<i>Delicate, bright yellow chains on compact plants. Easy to grow and Flower on many arching stems.</i>
Dendrochilum javierianum 'Super Mario'	BS	25	<i>Bright Yellow brushes on terete leafed plants</i>
Dendrochilum magnum 'P.I'	BS	45	<i>Long elegant streamers of cream flowers. The largest of the genus . These are blooming now to early fall.</i>
Dendrochilum propinquum 'Coral Tresses'	BS	25	<i>Stunning displays of spiraled cascades of coral flowers on this mid sized plant. A must have.</i>
Dendrochilum wenzelii 'Lemonade'	BS	25	<i>Rare yellow variant of this species.</i>
Dendrochilum wenzelii 'Ox Blood'	BS	25	<i>Red form of this toothbrush orchid with terete leaves.</i>
Dendrochilum yuccifolium	BS	30	<i>Unusual stiff, heavily veined leaves. Chains of delicate white flowers. Stunning.</i>

Oncidesa Goldflakes	BS	30	<i>Profusion of sunlight yellow and chocolate flowers in a tree shaped arrangement. Easy to grow and flower.</i>
Oncidium Misaki Twinkle Obry 'Crimson Gold'	BS	30	<i>Compact plants with lots of bright yellow and chocolate flowers. Fragrant (Twinkle x obryzatum)</i>
Oncidium Sharry Baby ' Ruby Doll'	BS	40	<i>The CHOCOLATE ORCHID. Fragrance of chocolate fill any room when these are in flower.</i>
Oncidium Tarifor Lady 'Taibung'	BS	35	<i>(Tarifor ruby x Tarifor Queen) Looking for chocolate scent? This prodgeny of Sharry Baby is a smaller improved version of Sharry baby with brighter red colour.</i>
Oncidium Twinkle 'Chian-Tzy Red'	BS	25	<i>Small plants that easily produce clouds of very fragrant medium pink flowers.</i>
Oncidium Twinkle ' CT White Strong'	BS	25	<i>Small plants that produce clouds of small, pale pink, very fragrant flowers.</i>
Oncidium Twinkle ' Fragrant Baby''	BS	25	<i>Small plants that produce clouds of small, white and yellow, very fragrant flowers.</i>

Paphiopedilum bellatulum	BS	40	<i>Big round white flowers heavily spotted with wine. Stunning.</i>
Paphiopedilum bellatulum f alba	BS	100	<i>Pristine white flowers on small robust plants. Very Rare .One avaiable</i>
Paphiopedilum delenatii	BS	45	<i>White, pink flushed slipper with darker pink pouch. Only Paph that is fragrant</i>
Paphiopedilum Hung Sheng Bay x Hung Sheng Sea	BS	25	<i>Lovely mottled leaves producing a beautiful slipper in various combinations of red, green, and white. Some will be solid red vinis. Every one will be different with unique variegated foliage. Great starter slippers.</i>
Paphiopedilum Paradise in Burgundy	BS	45	<i>(After James x King Charles) Red with the large full pink dorsal of the charlesworthii grandparent.</i>
Paphiopedilum Paul Parks	BS	95	<i>(sanderianum x addutum) Multifloral with very long reddish petals. Gorgeous.</i>
Paphiopedilum haynaldianum	BS	95	<i>Up to 6 colourful flowers on long graceful Inflorescences. Shades of green, purple and mahogany.</i>
Paphiopedilum philippinense	nBS	60	<i>Stately multifloral. Up to 6 flowers. Gold pouch with dark burgundy twisted petals and burgundy striped dorsal.</i>
Paphiopedilum rothschildianum	BS	80	<i>The king of Paphs. Huge stately flowers striped and spotted red chocolate</i>

Paphiopedilum venustum	BS	85	<i>Much sought after for its distinctive reticulated pouch and beautiful foliage. In spike. Very limited.</i>
Paphiopedilum Hung Shen Pink	BS	45	<i>(moquetteanum x emersonii) Pink and yellow flowers produced sequentially over a long time. Very rewarding to grow.</i>
Paphiopedilum Alexej	BS	65	<i>(hangianum x rothschildianum) Large golden flowers reticulated amounts of red chocolate</i>
Paphiopedilum Volcano Goddess	BS	75	<i>(Yang-Ji Apple x rothschildianum)3-4 Deeply coloured magnificent flowers.</i>

Phragmipedium warszewiczianum var wallisii	BS	75	<i>Stately green and white flowers with long twisted petals that keep growing as long they don't touch any surface.</i>
Phragmipedium Fireworks	BS	55	<i>(Grande x pearcei) The pearcei parent has brought down the size of the plant. Even with shorter petals than Grande the flowers are still majestic.</i>
Phragmipedium Hanne Popow	BS	50	<i>Reliable, easy grower with sequentially opening flowers in pink to orange to bicolor tones. (schlimii x besseae)</i>
Phragmipedium Incan Treasure	BS	80	<i>Bright pink blend of 2 parents. (kovachii x longifolium) Very striking.</i>
Phragmipedium QF Maria	BS	60	<i>(lindleyanum x dalessandroi) Good grower producing impressive branched inflorescences with brilliant orange red flower.</i>
Phragmipedium Zapatilla de la Virgen	BS	100	<i>Deeply coloured with extremely long petals. Stunning. (humboldii 'Fortuna x warszewiczianum) Petals grow to 2 feet long.</i>

Phalaenopsis bellina	BS	40	<i>('red Apple' x f, alba) Warm growing very fragrant yellow and pink stellate flowers.</i>
Phalaenopsis stuartiana	BS	45	<i>('Sogo'x v. nobilis) This is cross of the white and yellow forms so will be white to yellow with colourful spotting . Pretty silvered leaves.</i>
Phalaenopsis zebrina	BS	40	<i>White, stellate flowers marked with maroon in a zebra-like pattern. Warm. Fragrant.</i>
Phalaenopsis violacea f. indigo	BS	50	<i>For those looking for a a fragrant blue species. Grow it warm and it will definitely reward you.</i>
Phalaenopsis violacea f magenta	BS	50	<i>Bright magenta flowers. Another colour form of this very fragrant species.</i>
Phalaenopsis tetrapsis	BS	45	<i>Magenta and White stars. Each flower different and fragrant.</i>

	Pleurothallis niviglobula	BS	30	Miniature with tiny white flowers that give the appearance of speckled snow over the green leaves. Does great in a terrarium
	Pleurothallis palliolata 'Eichenfels'	BS	30	Pink clam shells on heart shaped leaves. We grow this because we love the shape of the leaves
	Pleurothallis scuerula	BS	30	Elongated heart-shaped leaves with pulpit shaped cream flowers
	Restrepia cuprea 'Copper Jewel' CHM/AOS	BS	35	Brilliant orange flowers appear almost all year round. Miniature.
	Restrepia brachypus 'Bird's Eye'	BS	30	Vvigorous miniature grower with reddish flowers on and off throughout the year.
	Scaphosepalum digitale	BS	35	Mature plants are very small, forming little tufts. Dark pink flowers. Intermediate temperatures.
	Scaphosepalum rapax 'Bad Hair Day'	BS	35	Miniature, sequentially flowering. Water buffalo like chocolate flowers. Does well mounted.
	Scaphosepalum swertifolium 'Pink Flamingo'	BS	40	Rewarding species that just keeps on flowering on the same stems for many, many months. Pink and chocolate flowers resemble water buffalos.
	Specklinia grobii	BS	30	Tufts of leaves that produce lots of yellow flowers. Charming tiny miniature.
	Specklinia picta 'Gigi'	BS	45	This a great species that quickly grows into a cushion of leaves. This is the rare red form that is usually light yellow.

Renanthera vietnamensis	BS	40	<i>Small plant with numerous brilliant red flower.</i>
Vanda (Neofinetia) falcata	BS	25	<i>Night fragrant white flowers with a long nectary. Miniature plants size.</i>
Holcostylis M S Sunlight	BS	25	<i>Try something unusual. This miniature Vandaceous hybrid produces lots of very fragrant, white flowers with gorgeous magenta lips. (Holc. flavescens x Rhy. gigantea)</i>
Vandachostylis Prapawan'Blue'	BS	40	<i>Fragrant deep violet flowers heavily reticulated deeper violet on strong upright stems.</i>
